



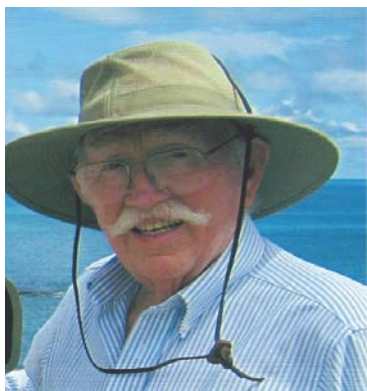

### 5 Year Airport Capital Improvement Plan

Every year, Cable Airport prepares a 5 year Capital Improvement Plan which is submitted to the FAA to allow them to anticipate future funding requests. The plan contains a number of projects including an AWOS, ramp improvements, runway and taxiway configuration changes, and land acquisition. The following are the top two priorities for the airport:

**2016 Project:** As reported a couple of month's ago, the Airport's 2016 project is the acquisition and installation of an AWOS. Since that article, the FAA has given the airport the go ahead to solicit bids for an AWOS III/P. Bid opening is scheduled for June 21st so, as of this time, we are on track to have an AWOS installed and operational by January 2017.

**2017 Project:** Planning has begun for the Airport to build a 15,000+ square foot hangar east of the main parking lot where the original hangars currently exist. The Airport anticipates submitting an FAA grant application by the end of 2016 for financial assistance on the infrastructure needed for this building. We will keep you updated.



### TENANTS CORNER: Frank Prentiss

Often times, Frank Prentiss can be seen doing laps early in the morning around the airport. He calls Aero Commander Hangar N home. We recently caught up with Frank and asked him a few questions:

1. **What do you fly?**  
Frank flies a tan antique 1961 Cessna 182

2. **How long have you been at Cable?**  
In 1970, Frank accepted a job at the Claremont Colleges and moved to Upland shortly after. He chose Cable because it was 2 miles from his North Upland home. Frank loved Dewey Cable and all the friends he made in the early days. He first rented space under one of the Cable's magnificent sheds then moved to his present location, Hangar N, at the invitation of "wizard" Wilson when the hangar was brand new.

3. **How long have you been flying?**  
Frank can never remember a time when he didn't love flying. His birthday gift each year, starting at age 13, was the \$2 plane ride that both Frank and his father would take out of Gardena Airport. Frank married his wife, Rose, in 1950 and after a stint in the Navy during the Korean War he went to work for the State of California and bought a house in Torrance. Frank, at that time, took on a second and third job to save up for flying lessons. When he had saved up \$500, Frank joined a flying club and began taking lessons. He has been flying since 1957 when he received his license at Compton Airport. Frank would wash airplanes at Compton Airport in return for flying time. When he moved to Upland in 1971, he started flying with Art Moore and Dennis Luckett. He eventually bought his first plane in 1974 which was a Stinson 1946. Since Frank has owned airplanes, he has flown around the country four times.

4. **What are your thoughts, in general, about Cable Airport?**

Frank stated that his years at Cable and the friends that he has made while being here have been the best years of his life.

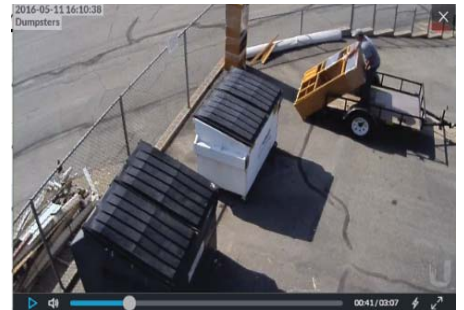


## THE TRASH BINS ARE FOR AIRPORT GENERATED TRASH ONLY

On May 10th, our trash bins were emptied at 8 AM and within 24 hours they were full again. Why? As our video shows, there were individuals that brought debris from off the airport. One individual brought in a truckload of debris onto the airport and another brought in, not one, but two trailer loads of debris including large pieces that were dumped next to the bins.

The Airport Office has been asked why we don't have another set of trash bins elsewhere on the field or why we don't have a larger rolloff box. The reason why is those bins would fill up just as fast as people would bring their debris from off the field. If the bins were only used for airport generated trash, they would have plenty of space for all the tenants.

If you have a need to dump a lot of debris, contact the Airport Office and they will make arrangements to accommodate your needs; otherwise, be forewarned, if it is observed that you are using the airport bins to dispose of your off field debris, you will be billed for the cost of trash bin.

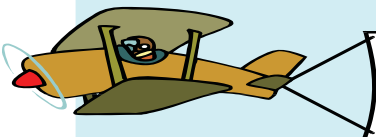
